## 1650 - 1651

BETWEEN 1650 AND 1651, THREE DOCUMENTS REFER TO THE ORIGIN OF THE CONGREGATION:

OCTOBER 15, 1950 - OPENNING OF THE COMMUNITY - THE DATE IS IN THE PREFACE OF THE FIRST EDITION OF THE CONSTITUTION - THE ONLY SOURCE OF INFORMATION ABOUT THE HISTORY OF THE ORIGINS OF THE SISTERS OF ST. JOSEPH.

MARCH 10, 1651 - "LETTRES DE PROVISIONS" -ECCLESIASTICAL APPROVAL OF THE CONGREGATION

DECEMBER 13, 1651 - CONTRACT OF THE ASSOCIATION BETWEEN THE SISTERS, SIGNED BY BISHOP HENRY DE

IN 1652, FATHER MÉDAILLE WAS MOVED TO AURILLAC, WHERE HE WORKED AS A TEACHER, PREACHER AND MISSIONARY.

FR. JEAN-PIERRE MÉDAILLE WAS TRANSFERRED TO BILLOM

WHERE HE LIVED IN A SENIOR CARE HOUSE FOR THE SICK AND THE ELDERLY PRIESTS. EVEN WITH HIS FRAGILE HEALTH, HE USED TO HEAR CONFESSIONS OF THE PEOPLE OUTSIDE THE COMMUNITY.
